### PLEASE NOTE:

1. Stalls may be set up from 12pm on day of event. All stalls must cease trading at 7pm and be packed up by 8pm. Your stall site and adjacent area must be left in a clean and tidy state with no rubbish left behind. [All trading from March to December will be 2pm -7pm]
2. A copy of your Public Liability Insurance Policy (ie Certificate of Currency) covering the date of the event, with proof of payment must be attached to this application.
3. Individual stall lighting is to be provided by the stall holder, and should be either solar, gas or battery.
4. Insurance for loss, damage and public liability is the responsibility of the stallholder. Boyne Tannum Arts Business & Community Assoc Inc (BTABC) will not be responsible for any loss or damage incurred by stalls or contents, or for damage caused by stallholders, their equipment or vehicles, to property or vehicles owned by either stallholders or contractors.
5. BTABC reserves the right to expel any stallholder and require such stallholder to be removed should the conduct of the stallholder be in any way detrimental to the well being of the event, or should the products/services be other than those stated in this agreement. In the case of such expulsion, monies paid to BTABC will not be refundable.
6. Fast food and soft drinks, water & fruit juice must not be sold at craft stalls.
7. No vehicles are to be driven on park land and overnight camping is not allowed.
8. Sand bags only, no pegs to be driven into ground because of underground power and water.

**Number of stalls will be limited to Maximum of 80 Choice of stalls will be at discretion of Boyne Tannum Arts Business Community Assoc Inc and their decision will be final.**
